I refer to the above Parliamentary Question which has been referred by the Minister for Health to the Health Service Executive for direct response.

I have provided below a breakdown of the number of outbreaks of Covid-19 in meat processing plants from 1<sup>st</sup> November 2020 by county:

Please note that in addition to outbreak testing we also undertake Serial Testing in meat and food processing plants. This commenced on 21st August 2020 following a request by the National Public Health Emergency Team (NPHET) to implement this programme. This Serial Testing is operating nationally within the agreed schedule which is once every four-weeks and is informed by guidance from HSE Public Health. We are testing approximately 85 meat and food processing facilities nationwide. Serial testing is now established as a core component of the overall testing and contact tracing service.
