1.	Staff on duty have received training in hand hygiene procedures within the last 2 years. (ask staff/check training records)		
2.	HCWs nails are short and clean and free from nail polish (including gel nails/enhancements)		
3.	No wrist watches, stoned rings or other wrist accessories including jewellery or fitbits are worn by delivering patient care (a single plain band ring only)		
4.	HCWs are observed to have bare wrists when delivering care (e.g. short sleeved top or rolled up sleeves are worn)		
5.	Clinical hand wash sink with hot water, soap, paper towel and lidded bin is available where care is provided and used for hand washing only		
6.	Alcohol hand rub is available for use at the point of care and are accessible when providing care		
7.	Posters demonstrating technique are prominently displayed		
8.	Pump operated or wall mounted emollient hand cream is available and in date for staff and they are aware of the location
