1.	Healthcare workers (HCWs) have received hand hygiene training within the past 2 years. Ask HCW on duty/check training records		
2.	HCWs nails are short, clean and free from nail varnish nail polish, nail enhancements		
3.	No hand or wrist jewellery are worn by staff on duty including stone rings and wrist watches (except plain band ring)		
4.	HCWs are observed to have bare wrists when delivering care (short sleeved top or sleeves rolled up)		
5.	Dedicated hand wash sinks with hot water, soap mounted in dispenser and paper towel is available where care is provided with unobstructed access		
6.	Alcohol hand rubs are available to staff and accessible at the point of care		
7.	Posters displaying hand hygiene technique are available and displayed in prominent areas		
8.	Appropriate designated hand creams (wall mounted/pump operated are available for staff which are in date and staff are aware of their location		
9.	Hand hygiene facilities are available to all patients/residents /clients. This includes a hand washing facility and/or disposable hand wipes
