



Behaviour that has no beneficial effects but <u>lots</u> of negative effects.




Effects of smoking during pregnancy

- Growth Retardation
- Placenta Abruption
- PPROM
- SIDS/ Subsequent Asthma
- Congenital Malformation
- Miscarriage
- Stillbirth

- Genetic Epigenetic
- Social influences
- Educational status
- Employment status
- Parenting behaviour
- Partner behaviour
