

Immunization saves lives, and diseases can be eliminated...




Reported cases in WHO European Region

Immunization is a basic right... but not accessible to all

Large groups of high-risk unvaccinated children still exist across European Region, who tend to be the most vulnerable

600,000 newborns miss routine immunization every year


32,000 young children die every year from vaccine-preventable diseases







Outbreaks of infectious diseases pose a serious threat...

- Place a special focus on vulnerable, high-risk groups
- Foster inter-country exchange of knowledge and experience

The 2005 WHO Regional Committee for Europe resolution EUR/RC55/R7 ... urged Member States to commit themselves and give high priority to achieving the measles and rubella elimination targets for 2010 ... to support the implementation of an immunization week for advocacy to promote immunization ...

Results EIW 2007 Information to key target groups

- → 124 different information materials developed
- ➡ 846,734 information products elaborated
- → 563,996 folders and leaflets distributed
- → 22,370 fact sheets provided
 - ➡ 34,231 immunization cards updated
- ➡ 701,202 SMS messages sent out
- ➡ 7,371 radio, TV messages or newspapers
- 106 web sites launched











Results EIW 2007 Engaging key target groups

- ➡ 546,901 high-risk persons immunized
- ➡ 1,491,352 vaccinations provided in total
 - 28 competitions held
 - 226 workshops or conferences held
 - 6,650 school lessons on immunization conducted
 - 732 training sessions carried out
